

The next screen to pop up will look like this:



Select save file. By doing this, the likelihood of the file becoming corrupted is diminished.

The next screen that will appear is the download screen. The file that needs to be loaded can be accessed by either going to the download file and save it to another location or by dragging and dropping the file onto the desktop.
